HPV stands for human papillomavirus.

HPV is so common that nearly everyone gets it at some point.

It can be passed with no signs or symptoms.

It dramatically increases the risk of serious cancer in both men and women.

Know the Facts

- HPV vaccines are safe.
- HPV vaccination does **NOT** cause fertility issues.
- The HPV vaccine does **NOT** contain harmful ingredients.
- The HPV vaccine is necessary, regardless of sexual activity.
- The HPV vaccine is effective and helps prevent cancer.
- The HPV vaccine is for boys and girls.



Early vaccination is better



Two doses of HPV vaccine are recommended **for girls and boys** ages 11-12.



The two-dose series can be started as **early as age 9**.



Teens and young adults (15-26) can still receive vaccination, but will require **three doses**.
