Mission: Transforming oral health through collaboration, innovation, education, and service



General Grant Guidelines

Qualified organizations can submit ONE Community Grant application

per year, ranging from \$2,500 to \$40,000. Applications can be submitted online within the application window, and approved funds must be used in the following calendar year.



Non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations

Qualified Organizations

Must be an Arkansas-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit, government agency, school, or charitable dental treatment facility.



Oral Health Impact

Your organization's program should focus on oral health, education, treatment, and/or disease prevention.



Equity Focus

All programs should focus on underserved Arkansans and have an explanation about why that community is underserved.

What We DO Fund:

- Program-specific administrative costs
- Program equipment and supplies
- One-time expenses
- Dental clinic expenses and supplies
- Operational expenses

What We DO NOT Fund:

- Direct dental staff salaries
- Payments to cover dental treatment
- Individuals grants must be awarded to an eligible organization
- Fundraising events/sponsorships
- Private foundations and endowments
- Reduction of organizational debt
- Excessive salary costs, travel, or incentives/gifts
- Programs that discriminate on any basis

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
